2020 “SHARE THE SPIRIT” 50/50 LOTTERY TICKET DRAW FACT SHEET

(Lottery License #LR20-0030)

The Ukrainian Catholic Foundation of Saskatchewan Corporation will be conducting the “Share the Spirit” 50/50 Lottery Draw. The following is information concerning the terms and conditions, as well as the rules of play, for this Lottery.

Number of Tickets Printed: 15,000

Price per Ticket: \$20.00 per each ticket

Total Maximum Prize Value: \$150,000.00

Draw Date: Friday, December 4th, 2020, 2:00pm at 214 Avenue M S, Saskatoon SK

Distribution of Lottery Proceeds and Prizes:

- 50% of the ticket sale proceeds will go the winner of the “Share the Spirit” 50/50 Lottery Draw, or \$10.00 from each ticket sold. *Example: If 3,000 tickets were sold, the winner of the lottery draw would receive \$30,000, or (3,000 X \$20.00 X 50%)*
- The other 50% of the ticket sale proceeds will be divided on a 50/50 basis between UCFSASK and Parishes/Missions or Eparchial Organizations as explained below:
 - ✓ Provision on each lottery ticket will be made that will enable the purchaser of a ticket to name a Parish/Eparchial Organization as the “Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization Designation” on the ticket. The organization named as the “Parish/Eparchial Organization Designation” on the ticket will receive \$5.00 (25% of the ticket price of \$20.00) from each ticket sold where they are named as the “Parish/Eparchial Organization Designation”.
*Example: Suppose that out of the 3,000 (as per above example) there were 715 tickets sold where the “Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization Designation” named on the ticket by ticket purchasers was St. Basil’s Parish in Regina. As a result, St. Basil’s would receive \$3,575.00 (715 X \$5.00). Further, suppose that there were 310 tickets sold where the “Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization Designation” named on the ticket by ticket purchasers was St. Michael’s Camp (Kamsack). As a result, St. Michael’s Camp would receive \$1,550 (310 X \$5.00) --- and so on and so forth, until the entire 25% of sale proceeds have been allocated to **ALL** the “Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization Designation” named on the ticket by ticket purchasers.*
 - ✓ Considerations regarding the “Designated Beneficiary” Concept:
 - Every Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization will receive funds from each ticket sold where they are named as the “Parish/Eparchial Organization Designation”.
 - Where no “Parish/Eparchial Organization Designation” is named by the ticket purchaser on the ticket purchased, the \$5.00 portion of the ticket will go directly to UCFSASK.
 - The “Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization Designation” will need to be either a Parish which is a member of the Eparchy of Saskatoon, or an Eparchial Organization that is under the auspices of the Eparchy of Saskatoon, and appointed by the UCFSASK as an Eparchial Organization qualified to be designated as beneficiary of the ticket sales proceeds.
 - The UCFSASK will designate four such Eparchial Organizations. They will be as follows:
 - ✓ St. Michael’s Ukrainian Catholic Church Camp Inc (Kamsack)
 - ✓ St. Volodymyr Ukrainian Catholic Camp (Saskatoon)
 - ✓ Ukrainian Catholic Religious Education Centre
 - ✓ Ukrainian Catholic Foundation of Saskatchewan Corporation
 - ✓ The above four Eparchial Organizations are in addition to any Ukrainian Catholic Parish/Mission in the Eparchy of Saskatoon.
 - A ticket purchaser who purchases more than one ticket could name a different “Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization Designation” on each ticket purchased, or the ticket purchaser could name the same “Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization” on each of the additional tickets purchased.

- The other 25%, or \$5.00, of each ticket sold will go directly to UCFSASK. UCFSASK will be responsible to pay for all expenses associated with this lottery. The proceeds of the portion of the lottery proceeds attributable to UCFSASK will be used to assist UCFSASK in promoting the cultural, social, educational and spiritual initiatives, policies, and objectives of the Eparchy of Saskatoon among Ukrainian Catholics in the Province of Saskatchewan.

Ticket Distribution:

- A book of tickets containing five (5) individual tickets will be mailed out to each Parish Family Unit throughout the Eparchy of Saskatoon in Saskatchewan. Parish Family Units will be asked to return **BOTH SOLD AND UNSOLD TICKETS** back to UCFSASK in the self-addressed envelope enclosed with the mail out package. This self-addressed envelope can be placed in the collection plate at their local Ukrainian Catholic Parish, who will then forward this envelope to the UCFSASK Office; or, the self-addressed envelope can be mailed back directly to the Foundation Office.
- “Share the Spirit” 50/50 Lottery Tickets will also be made available to any Parish or appointed Eparchial Organization wanting to sell these 50/50 tickets on behalf of their Parish/Mission/Eparchial Organization. These organizations will name themselves as the “Parish/Eparchial Organization Designation” and would receive the 25%, or \$5.00, for each ticket sold.
- ***IMPORTANT: ALL “SHARE THE SPIRIT” 50/50 LOTTERY TICKETS, SOLD OR UNSOLD, MUST BE RETURNED BACK TO THE UCFSASK OFFICE BY NOVEMBER 25TH, 2020 – 5:00PM***

Rules of Play

- Commencement of Sale of Lottery Tickets: September 30th, 2020
- The purchase of the 50/50 Lottery Tickets and the winning of the prize will be restricted to individuals 18 years of age and older.
- Employees and Board of Directors of Ukrainian Catholic Foundation of Saskatchewan, and their immediate family will be eligible to participate (and be able to win) in the “Share the Spirit” Lottery.
- The Lottery Draw will be supervised by the CPA firm of Baker Tilly LLP (Saskatoon), and the actual draw made by one member of the CPA firm of Baker Tilly LLP (Saskatoon). The Draw will also be witnessed by two people from the UCFSASK organization as well as at least one person from the Eparchy of Saskatoon. The draw will be open to the public.
- Ticket Sales will close on **Wednesday, December 2nd, 2020 (2:00pm)**. Tickets mailed to the UCFSASK Office must be postmarked on or before **November 25th, 2020** to be eligible for the draw.
- The “Share the Spirit” 50/50 Lottery Draw will be made on **Friday, December 4th, 2020** at 2:00pm CST at the UCFSASK Office located at 214 Avenue M South, Saskatoon SK S7M 2K4. The potential winner need not be present during the draw proceedings.
- The holder of the winning ticket will be notified immediately by telephone. The winning ticket number will be posted on the UCFSASK website (www.usfsask.org) for one year. The method of making the winning prize available to the winner will be determined at the time of notification and discussion with the lottery winner.
- The winner of the lottery will have up to one year to claim the cash prize. An unclaimed prize will be held for one year. If unclaimed after one year has passed, the prize amount will be donated to a charity approved by SLGA. UCFSASK will make multiple attempts to reach the winning ticket holder.
- The “Share the Spirit” 50/50 Lottery prize is cash only, so there are no alternative prizes offered.
- Only the tickets sold will be eligible for the draw.

Audit of the Lottery:

The accounting firm of Baker Tilly LLP (Saskatoon) will be engaged to complete the audit of the sold and unsold tickets and will be requested to issue a report to UCFSASK.

Past “Share the Spirit” 50/50 Lottery Draw Winners

2018 - Steve Schebel from Foam Lake SK, and winning cash prize was \$29,440.00.

2019 – Gary Sereda from Saskatoon SK, and the winning cash prize was \$29,220.00

In addition, **\$29,3330.00** was distributed to Parishes/Missions and Eparchial Organizations named as “Designated Beneficiaries” on the Lottery tickets that were purchased over the past two years.
