When the Sheptytsky Institute building was sold, the proceeds of sale were used to establish the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation Grant Program. The investment income generated by this fund will be used to provide grant funds to Parishes/Missions and Eparchial Organizations approved by the Eparchy of the Saskatoon Eparchy.

The Ukrainian Catholic Foundation of Saskatchewan (UCFSask) has been commissioned to administer the Sheptytsky Institute Fund and the grant funding program for the Eparchy.

UCFSask will consider applications for grants from Parishes/Missions and approved Eparchial Organizations for projects/initiatives that align with the Foundation's mission and purpose. In addition, grant allocations will also be guided by the recommendations for action from the Eparchial 2014 SOBOR Document – The Vibrant Parish.

In 2020, the Foundation has already distributed \$54,000.00 of these grant funds to provide support to parishes during the COVID-19 pandemic. The remaining balance left over to distribute in 2020 is \$17,000.00.

To ensure that the funding is available to all eligible organizations across the Eparchy, the amount of grant funding available for distribution will be divided by Deanery based on the number of family units in each Deanery, with 10% of the fund available to approved Eparchial Organizations. Using this formula, the grant funds available for distribution will be allocated for projects/initiatives within the Deaneries and Eparchial Organizations as follows:

- Prince Albert Deanery (13%) - \$1,989
- Regina Deanery (15%) - \$2,295
- Saskatoon Deanery (38%) - \$5,814
- Yorkton Deanery – (34%) \$5,202
- Eparchial Organizations – (10%) - \$1,700

To receive this grant fund money, Parishes/Missions or Eparchial Organizations will be required to complete a grant application form. The application form is available under the “Grant” tab on the Foundation’s website at www.ucfsask.org. More detailed information concerning the grant fund, and the criteria under which grants will be considered is also available under the “Grants” tab on the website.

Parishes/Missions or Eparchial Organizations wishing to apply for a grant should complete and submit their “grant application form”, to the Foundation Office by **5:00pm November 30, 2020**
